## Viewing and Printing

### If you have Adobe Acrobat Professional (Acrobat DC):

Open Acrobat Professional. From the File Menu, open the postscript (.PS) file.

If you'd like to keep this version, save it (File > Save). Each time you open the file, it creates a new version of the zine.

You can print directly from Acrobat.

### If you have a Mac:

Double-clicking a .PS file should open directly in Apple's Preview program.

If you'd like to keep this version, save it (File > Save). Each time you open the file, it creates a new version of the zine.

You can print directly from Preview

### If you are running Windows:

*Windows cannot natively open a .PS file. You will need a converter such as Rampant Logic's Postscript Viewer which will allow you to open .PS files in Acrobat Reader.*

Once you have installed the viewer, double-clicking the .PS file should open it in Acrobat Reader.
